## INGREDIENTS

From Snow (9900 11), cut:

* $\{A\}(2) 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2$ " rectangles
* $\{B\}(2) 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
* \{C\} (2) $2^{1 ⁄ 2}{ }^{2} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
* $\{D\}$ (4) $2 ½{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares
* $\{E\}$ (2) $2 \frac{112}{2}$ " $\times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
* $\{F\}$ (4) $1^{\prime \prime}$ squares
* $\{G\}(12) 1 ½$ squares

From Peacock (9900 216), cut:

* $\{H\}(6) 2 \frac{1 ⁄ 2}{2} \times 6 \frac{1 ⁄ 2}{2}$ " rectangles
* \{1\} (4) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
* $\{J\}(2) 2 ½ " \times 5 ½ "$ rectangles
* $\{G\}(4) 11 / 2$ " squares

From Geranium (9900 258), cut:

* $\{\mathrm{L}\}$ (4) $31 / 4$ " squares

From Bubble Gum (9900 88), cut:

* $\{\mathrm{L}\}(4) 31 / 4{ }^{1}$ squares

Garnish:

* $11 / 8$ yard of $1 / 4$ " Rick-Rack or ribbon



## PEPPERMINT MITTENS

## STEP 1. MAKE PEPPERMINT

On the wrong side of (4) peppermint color 2 squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Pair right sides together with (1) peppermint color 2 square. Stitch $1 / 4$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the line. Press. Trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat for remaining peppermint squares to create a total of (8) $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " HSTs. Join together in sets of 4 to create pinwheels that measure $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Mark a diagonal pencil lin on the wrong side of (8) $1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ mitten squares. Use these to create ECTs on the peppermints as shown. Add a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ mitten rectangle to each side of the peppermint pinwheel. Press toward rectangle. Should measure $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## STEP 2. MAKE MITTEN

Make ECTs: On the wrong side of (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ background squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Using (1) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ mitten rectangle and (2) $11 / 2 "$ background squares place a square on opposite corners. Sew on the line, trim $1 / 4 "$ from the sewn line (trim line indicated by the dotted line). Press toward square.
Repeat for a total of ( 6 ) $2 \frac{1}{2} /^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " mitten rectangles and (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " background squares. Press toward square on 4 of these units and press toward mitten rectangle on 2 of these units.
Join ECT units and peppermint units as shown. Add the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to the side of the unit. Square to $7 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ wide $\times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall
On the wrong side of (4) 1 " background squares and (2) $21 / 2 \prime$ " background squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Add (2) $1^{\prime \prime}$ background squares and (1) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ background square to a $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ mitten rectangle. **Sew on the line, trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the sewn line (trim line indicated by the dotted line). Press toward squares. Make 2.
**Note: Watch Angle of Stitching Line
Add (1) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ background square and (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square to thumb unit. Make 2. Should measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Attach thumbs to mittens. Measures $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Add (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of the mitten and (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9{ }^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom of the mitten. Press toward background. Make 2 Should measure $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2 "}$.


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## STEP 3. ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Assemble the block as shown. Measures $181 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished.


Using $11 / 8$ yard of $1 / 4 "$ Rick-Rack or ribbon, stitch a cord connecting both mittens. Use a frixion pen to mark a stitching line for the rick-rack. Use main picture as a guide.
